This will have 80+20 (I.A) 100 Marks. Internal Assessment marks 20. All papers written Examination of Three hour's duration will be held. Total marks 400.

Course of Study & Syllabus for "Advanced Diploma" Course in Santali, Bhasha-Bhavana, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan, West Bengal

Advance Diploma course in Santali will be comprise of four papers of 100 marks each. First three papers written examination of three hours duration will be held for 80 marks while 20 marks will be set apart for Internal Assessment. In all cases candidates will be required to question the answer in Santali. They have to use the ol Chiki script while answering questions in their written examination.
