Examination guideline of Course-work

- On successful completion of the course work, a synopsis of the proposed study will be submitted by the candidate and a presentation of the same will be made before the Board of Studies of the concerned department for recommendation of the theme/title of Research and assigning of a Supervisor.
- Time schedule of examination of course work will be decided by the Bhavana in consultation with department.
