Due to the huge number of queries regarding the mode of the MCQ online test tomorrow (13/9/21), CJMC has decided to bring in minor changes in the written test modalities. Tomorrow (13/09/2021), by 10.55 AM, all eligible candidates will receive 50 questions having four options each as attachments to their email id mentioned in the application form. Every candidate has to read questions and options to type the correct option (a or b or c or d against question number, e.g. 1 - c, 5 - a) in a sheet sent to the candidate. The sheet has to be downloaded and candidates have to write their names & Visva-Bharati IDs in the same, along with the options to be written.

After this, the candidate has to return the answer sheet as a document file by return mail (to the mail address from which the question would be sent) by 12.05 PM. In case there is the delay of more than five minutes(i.e. beyond 12.05 PM) the candidature will not be considered.

Only in case of any candidate, who offers online proof of the delay due to the network problem, the return mail will be accepted up to 12.15 PM, provided it is sent from the official mail id (i.e. the id which is in the application).
