M. Sc. Admission Test (online) 2021-22 for the Department of Computer and System Sciences, Institute of Science, Visva-Bharati as per the new schedule

The online test of 100 marks comprises two phases –

1. Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of 40 marks. There will be 20 questions each with four options and of 2 marks. Among the four options exactly one option is appropriate, which an examinee is expected to identify and opt. Examinees may attempt all the questions. A correct choice will earn two marks and a wrong one or non-attempted one will attract no marks.

In view of the written admission test conducted on 13.9.2021 (scheduled during 1.30 pm to 2.30 pm) getting disturbed because of technical glitch, it has been decided that a fresh written test for M. Sc admission will be conducted cancelling the earlier one as per the following –

Mode of written test: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) in online mode
Revised date: 18.9.2021
Revised time: 10.00 am to 11.00 am (One hour duration)

2. Viva voce of 60 marks was conducted online using google meet. The entire session was recorded. The schedule of the Viva voce was as follows –
Date: 14.9.2021, 15.9.2021
Time: 10.00 am onwards on both days.

Merit list will be prepared based on the performance of both the above. **An examinee appearing in only one out of the two will not be considered in the list.** Reservation criteria will be adhered to as per the rules of Govt. of India. The final merit list will be notified in the university website duly.

For the MCQ test, the candidates are requested to go through the following carefully.

1. Your attempt in the test will imply that you are accepting and declaring that you are the original candidate, and the test is taken by yourself only. You will not adopt any unfair means in answering the questions. It would also imply that you have not shared your log-in credentials to anyone else.
2. There will be 20 multiple choice questions and each question has 4 options, you can select only one.
3. There is no negative mark for wrong answers.
4. The portal for admission test will be open at right time. **If you log-in beforehand you need to Refresh the webpage immediately at the test opening time.**
5. If any candidate fails to meet the time schedule, department/university will not take any responsibility. In this context, it may be noted that the session will be automatically deactivated exactly on completion of one hour and no submission will be allowed by the system beyond that time schedule. Moreover, once submitted, the system will not allow any rollback and no post-submission request, whatsoever, in this regard will be entertained.
6. For any type of disruption in internet connectivity in your side, department/university will not take any responsibility.
7. Candidates can take part in admission test with any android or similar mobile phone/desktop or laptop with minimum internet facility.

8. If any unfair means or irregularity is detected or found even after the online test and/or canvassing in any form, penalty will be imposed as per the university rules.
