Ph. D Admission Test (online) 2021-22 for the Department of Computer and System Sciences, Institute of Science, Visva Bharati

The online test of 100 marks comprises two phases –

1. Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of 40 marks. There will be 20 questions each with four options and of 2 marks. Among the four options exactly one option is appropriate, which an examinee is expected to identify and opt. Examinees may attempt all the questions. A correct choice will earn two marks and a wrong one or non-attempted one will attract no marks. Time duration of the MCQ test is of one hour with the following schedule –

Date: 13.9.2021, Time: 10.00 am to 11.00 am.

2. Viva voce of 60 marks to be conducted online using google meet. The entire session will be recorded. An examinee not attended MCQ will not be allowed to attend the Viva voce. The schedule of the Viva voce will be as follows –

Date: 13.9.2021, Time: 3.00 pm. Onwards

Based on the performance of the two above, those who qualify exceeding cutoff will be asked to appear before the Department Research Committee (DRC) scheduled on 28.9.2021. The DRC shall finalize the merit list from the candidates qualified the test above and other applicants having qualified NET/SLET/SET/GATE. Reservation criteria will be adhered to as per the rules of Govt. of India. The final merit list will be notified in the university website duly.

M. Sc. Admission Test (online) 2021-22 for the Department of Computer and System Sciences, Institute of Science, Visva Bharati

The online test of 100 marks comprises two phases –

1. Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of 40 marks. There will be 20 questions each with four options and of 2 marks. 2. Viva voce of 60 marks to be conducted online using google meet. The entire session will be recorded. An examinee not attended MCQ will not be allowed to attend the Viva voce. The schedule of the Viva voce will be as follows –

Date: 14.9.2021, 15.9.2021, Time: 10.00 am. Onwards on both days.

Merit list will be prepared based on the performance of the two above. Reservation criteria will be adhered to as per the rules of Govt. of India. The final merit list will be notified in the university website duly.

For all the MCQ test, the candidates are requested to go through the following carefully.

- 1. Your attempt in the test will imply that you are accepting and declaring that you are the original candidate, and the test is taken by yourself only. You will not adopt any unfair means in answering the questions. It would also imply that you have not shared your log-in credentials to anyone else.
- 2. There will be 20 multiple choice questions and each question has 4 options, you can select only one.
- 3. There is no negative mark for wrong answers.
- 4. The portal for admission test will be open at right time. If you log-in beforehand you need to <u>Refresh</u> the webpage immediately at the test opening time.
- 5. If any candidate fails to meet the time schedule, department/university will not take any responsibility. In this context, it may be noted that the session will be automatically deactivated exactly on completion of one hour and no submission will be allowed by the system beyond that time schedule. Moreover, once submitted, the system will not allow any rollback and no post-submission request, whatsoever, in this regard will be entertained.
- 6. For any type of disruption in internet connectivity in your side, department/university will not take any responsibility.
- 7. Candidates can take part in admission test with any android or similar mobile phone/desktop or laptop with minimum internet facility.
- 8. If any unfair means or irregularity is detected or found even after the online test and/or canvassing in any form, penalty will be imposed as per the university rules.
