Reservation Guidelines for Admission: The reservation policy of the Government of India will be followed.

i. Reservation in admission to all courses of the University shall strictly be done as per Government of India rules*.

ii. Percentage of Reservation: 15% seats for SC candidates, 7.5% seats for ST, 27% seats for OBC candidates, 10% seats for EWS candidates and 5% seats for PWD candidates (Horizontal Reservation).

* **Not more than one type of relaxation shall be granted to any candidate.**

Other Backward Class (OBC)

Applicants under OBC category are necessarily required to produce valid NCL certificates to claim the benefit of reservation of seats under OBC category. Link- http://www.ncbc.nic.in/user_panel/centralliststateview.aspx.

Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)

[UGC (MHRD) Order F.No.81-1/2019 (CU) dated 18th January, 2019] CRITERIA OF INCOME & ASSETS:

a. Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh) only are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Further candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

b. The property held by a “Family” in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

c. The term “Family” for the purpose will include the person who seeks benefits of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

Income and Asset certificate issuing Authority and Verification of certificate:

a. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format only be accepted as proof of candidate’s claim as belonging to EWS:

District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate /Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner; Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate; Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

b. The officers who issue the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the respective State/UT.

c. The crucial date for submitting income and asset certificates by the candidate may be treated as the closing date for receipt of application.

PWD : As per the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, not less than 5% seats are reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (persons with not less than 40% of disability) subject to valid disability certificate issued by the competent authority.

Neighbourhood Candidates: 20% out of total number of seats will be reserved for the Neighbourhood candidates who reside within 1 km of Siksha-Satra campus (Localities: Sriniketan, Surul, Rathindra Pally, Cheepkuthi and Moldanga).

Staff Wards: Wards of Permanent Staff members of Visva-Bharati.

Admission of Permanent Staff wards : The wards of Permanent Staff members can also apply to a class appropriate for his/ her age from Pre-Primary-1st Year, Santosh Pathshala to any class in Siksha-Satra up to Class VIII, provided they did not apply on earlier occasions. The staff concerned must be a Permanent employee who is in service at the time of admission of the ward.

Mode of Selection :

For Pre-Primary-1st Year, Santosh Pathshala : Computerized random selection procedure through the computerized lottery system will be followed. Date, time and place will be notified later on the Online admission portal: visvabharatiadmission.samarth.edu.in.

For Class II : Admission Test (Online / Offline). Date, time and place will be notified later on the Online admission portal: visvabharatiadmission.samarth.edu.in.

Merit list of Class II:

- a) Merit list will be prepared solely on the basis of results/marks/score of the Admission Test (offline/online).
- b) If two or more applicants rank the same in the merit list, preference will be given to the candidate senior by birth.

How to Apply:

Candidates must apply through online Admission Portal of the university i.e., visvabharatiadmission.samarth.edu.in only. No offline application shall be accepted.

Mode of payment: Candidates can make payment online using any of the online payment modes: Net Banking, Debit Card and Credit Card.

No Cash payment will be allowed.

Please make payment from the Bank Account of the Parents/Guardians of the candidate to avoid any problem regarding refund, if any at any stage.

Documents to be uploaded/ submitted / produced: Following documents are to be submitted, subject to production of the originals at the time of admission and verification. Otherwise, the candidature will be cancelled.

1. Birth Registration Certificate issued by the competent Government Birth Registration Authority. (Form No. 5 or Form No. 9)

2. Valid Certificates from appropriate Government authorities in case of SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS candidates (either of candidate or father only).
3. Valid Disability Certificate from the competent government authorities for the candidates with disabilities.
4. Visva-Bharati Staff ID Card for Permanent Staff wards.
5. Copy of online application form.
6. Medical Certificate issued by a Registered Medical practitioner.
7. Blood Group Certificate of the candidate.
8. Three Passport size coloured Photographs (during physical submission).

Additional Documents for Neighbourhood candidates:

1. Photocopy of the parents' ration card.
2. Photocopy of the candidate's ration card.
3. Photocopy of the parents' Voter card issued by the Election Commission of India.

General Guidelines

- A set of photocopies of relevant documents, duly attested, will have to be submitted at the time of admission.
- School Leaving Certificate from the school last attended is to be submitted after admission, if applicable.
- Applicants are advised to visit the online admission portal (visvabharatiadmission.samarth.edu.in) for details and updates (inclusion/omission) at regular intervals.
- The modalities of Admission Test (wherever applicable) for the Institute will be informed from time to time on the Admission Portal.
- The full marks of Admission Test for Class – II is 50. Details of the said Admission Test will be notified in due course through the admission portal.
- The candidates must bring medical fitness certificate from any hospital or doctor with valid registration number at the time of admission.
- The Medical Insurance is mandatory. All candidates are required to pay medical insurance fee. Amount mentioned in the fee structure may change and will be informed in due course.
- For SC/ST/OBC/EWS certificate, the certificate of the father of the applicant may be uploaded/ submitted, if the same has not yet been obtained from the competent authority in the name of the child.
- It is mandatory for all admitted students to be present in the classes for the first fifteen (15) working days from the commencement of classes (online/offline). Otherwise, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.
- 15% of intake capacity at the university level will be made available for international students/foreign students which will be calculated as supernumerary seats. 5% of seats out of the 15% supernumerary seats for admission of foreign students shall be earmarked for children of Indian workers in the Gulf and South East Asia.
- Candidates / Parents must be very careful during entry of relevant information on the portal. No claim shall be entertained subsequently for data entry mistakes committed by the applicants/parents at the time of online application.

- **Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. Request for any sort of addition or alternation in the application form after submission will not be entertained.**
- ***Visva-Bharati Prospectus-2021* (available at: https://visvabharati.ac.in/file/VB_Adm_Prospectus_2021_2022.pdf) shall be followed for any issue or point that is not mentioned in this notification.**
- In case of non-availability of any candidate in a particular category (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/UR) under neighborhood category, that seat will be filled-up by a candidate of the same category under Non-neighborhood category, and vice versa.
