You may be aware that the Secretary, UGC, vide his D.O. letter No. 75-1/2013 (E-Governance) dated 20th April, 2015 addressed to the Vice Chancellor has informed the willingness of the UGC to introduce e-Governance in the working (URL : http://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/1679017_e-gov.pdf). As a first step, your University is required to register itself through URL : http://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/4566305_user_registration.pdf. Once the registration process of your University is complete, the same will be scrutinised and approved by the Nodal Officer of the UGC. As soon as the registration of university is approved, a user I.D. for your University will be activated. However, for the registration, you are required to get ready with the scanned copy of Identity Card (both sides) and a copy of the above referred D.O. letter sent by the Secretary, UGC. The details of the process involved are available on the UGC website under heading "User Manual (Version 1.0)".


In view of the above decision of the Commission, you are further informed that the Commission has decided to launch online application of Women's Studies Centre w.e.f. 15th August, 2015. For the purpose, the Women's Studies Centres established and functioning in your University is required to visit e-scheme portal of the UGC available on its website to fill up the data in respect of Women's Studies Centre. You may note that the filling/uploaded of the data for the Study Centre will have to be started from Phase-I onwards and till the data upto the present Phase is filled up / uploaded. As soon as the data for Phase-I is filled/uploaded, a mail may be sent to Ms. Dazy Chandna, Nodal Officer of UGC at dazy.ugc@nic.in

You may note that this exercise is proposed to be completed by 30th September, 2015 in respect of final Phase of Women's Studies Centre of your university. You are, therefore, requested to accordingly plan and ensure your university is registered with the UGC (through above referred URL) and data in respect of Women's Studies Centre is also filled/uploaded, by stipulated date.

I would like to bring to your kind notice that further grants, beyond 1st October, 2015, will be released only on completion of this exercise.
