
INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. This examination paper contains **EIGHT (8)** questions in total. The maximum attainable marks are 80.
2. There are **two sections** in this question paper - A, and B, having 6 and 2 questions respectively.
 - (a) Section A - This part of the paper consists of **6 Multiple Choice Questions**. You have to choose the correct answer from the set of options given to you, along with an explanation (less than 50 words). Each correct answer will get you **5 points**. The questions with multiple correct options have been indicated in the question paper explicitly. In order to qualify for evaluation of the 2nd section, you need to score 15 points or higher in this section.
 - (b) Section B - This part consists of **2 Subjective Questions** with sub-questions, where you need to arrive at the correct answer while working out the problem in full. The subdivision of marks has been indicated in the question paper. The total marks for each question is **25 points**.
3. For multiple correct questions in Section A, selecting all the correct options will fetch you 5 points, and anything else gets you a zero.
4. You have the freedom to choose the kind of paper you wish to write your answers on, but the duty of ensuring that the answers are legible lies with you.
5. You will have to scan your answers when you conclude answering the questions and attach the .pdf file through the Google form link provided to you.
6. You are allowed to use references without a penalty given that you cite these references in your answer sheet. Please provide correct titles with page numbers in case you cite a book.
7. Plagiarised answers without references will lead to a penalty up to 20%, depending on the severity of the particular case.
8. Unattempted questions will not affect your score.

9. You have 2 hours to write your answers (3:00 pm to 5:00 pm).
10. An additional 15 minutes will be given for scanning and uploading your answers. The Google form will stop accepting responses at 5:15 pm, without any exceptions.

Guidelines for the students:

1. All questions are mandatory.
2. There are two sections in the paper:
 - Section A - This part of the paper consists of **10** MCQ questions. You have to choose the correct answer from the set of options given to you, along with an explanation (less than 50 words). Each correct answer will get you **4 points**. In order to qualify for evaluation of the 2nd section, you need to score above 60% of the points in this section (i.e. $\geq 10 \times 4 \times 0.6 = 24$). There is only one correct answer to each question in this section. Filling up multiple responses will be treated as an incorrect response. There is no negative marking for incorrect responses.
 - Section B - This part consists of **5** subjective questions where you need to arrive at the correct answer while working out the problem in full. Each correct answer will get you **8 points**. You need not derive any fundamental formulas which you will use while answering the questions, however you must mention the formula which you are using.
3. The maximum marks for the paper are **80**.
4. You have the freedom to choose the kind of paper you wish to write your answers on, but the duty of ensuring that the answers are legible lies with you.
5. You will have to scan your answers when you conclude answering the questions and attach the .pdf file through the Google form link provided to you.
6. You are allowed to use references without a penalty given that you cite these references in your answer sheet. Please provide correct titles with page numbers in case you cite a book.
7. Plagiarized answers without references will lead to a penalty up to disqualification, depending on the severity of the particular case.
