
ABOUT THE SPEAKERS:



María Rosa Lojo is the academic director of the Centre of Critical Studies of Argentine Literature in the University of Salvador. She is also one of the most prominent Argentine authors. Her book *Las libres del Sur* (2013) deals with Victoria Ocampo and her milieu. The book has been translated into English and is currently being translated into Bangla by Abdullah Rafique-um-Munir Chowdhury.

Abdullah Rafique-um-Munir Chowdhury teaches Spanish and Translation Studies at Institute of Modern Languages, University of Dhaka. He is an award-winning translator, writer and editor with ten-something books to his name. His translations (from Spanish and English into Bangla) include fiction, non-fiction and poetry. He is currently translating *Las libres del Sur* into Bangla.





Shyama Prasad Ganguly is former Professor of JNU in Spanish and Latin American studies (1978-2012) specialising in Economic and Comparative culture studies. He has done pioneering work on Tagore's reception in Spain/Latin America and (Cervantes') *El Quijote* in India. He has authored, edited, translated 26 books and numerous articles on Spanish and Latin American themes. He has served as interpreter and has been involved in serious theatre for six decades.
