1. Theme of Seminar

Identity of various castes, classes and communities had always been one of the most obvious yet challenging phenomenon for country like India. The Tribal, the Dalit, the Woman and other marginalized society of the country apart from various other communities, castes and classes had faced this since beginning. The question is how to look at the question of Identity (Tribal, Dalit, Marginalized, Subaltern, Woman & Gender etc.) Formation and Formulation historically, socially & culturally and how its practice in our society is getting reflected in our modern art practices.

Identity of human class, caste and community is nothing but a performed entity. We exist as a class, caste or community because we practice identical things in a certain fashion. That identical practice of various classes, castes and communities transform them into their social Identity. In a greater sense we are nothing but either identical or non-identical performed entities. So, the question of Identity is core to our very idea of being. As, the genesis of Identity is the core idea behind human evaluation, it could be identified in all kinds of practices as well, whether Social, Cultural, Civilizational or Political.

In an increasingly globalized world, the notions of identity—cultural, social, political, and personal—are in constant flux. Modern art practices (theatre, music, dance, visual art, literature & cinema) are both reflective of and influential in shaping these identities. As artists engage with themes of representation, marginalization, and self-expression, they confront crises that challenge traditional paradigms of identity formation. This conference aims to explore the complexities of identity in contemporary art practices, examining how these practices respond to and influence the ongoing discourse around identity among tribal, dalit, woman, gender, nation and other identities.

However, we promote multilingual environment, the medium of paper presentations and published papers should be Hindi, English & Bengali only.
