## Qualification for Membership and Application Procedure

Membership in the IAU is open to countries (National Membership) and individuals (Individual or Junior Membership). The procedures for submission and approval of applications in the two categories are described in the IAU Working Rules (§ II and III). A brief summary of the procedure for seeking nomination for IAU Individual or Junior Membership is given below.

*Please note that a new category of membership, the **Junior Member** has been approved at the IAU XXX General Assembly (August 2018). Now researchers who have just completed their PhD in a branch of astronomy/astrophysics can be proposed as IAU Junior Member. The admission of new **Junior Members** will be evaluated annually by the [Membership Committee](#) and approved by the [Executive Committee](#). Junior Membership is temporary and cannot be extended for more than six years.*

- **IAU Individual or Junior Membership: Nomination of a candidate residing in a National Member country**

As a rule, Individual Membership in the IAU is open to scientists with a PhD or equivalent in a branch of astrophysics.

Junior Membership is open to individuals who have completed the PhD studies and who are in the initial phase of the professional researcher career in some branch of astronomy.

An **Individual or Junior Member** may be admitted to the IAU by the Executive Committee on the basis of nominations approved by the National Committee for Astronomy (NCA) in their **country of employment** (when no NCA exists, through the Adhering Organization in that country).

Individuals applying for nomination for IAU **Individual or Junior Membership** should contact their [NCA or Adhering Organization](#) (whichever applies) in their country of work in order to receive the link to the application form. This should be done before **December 15th, 2020**, so that these applications can be processed for approval in time for their submission to the IAU (see below). The call for membership applications to be submitted is open as of **October of 2020**. Individual and Junior Membership applications are submitted annually.

The procedure is electronic, via forms made available by the IAU to the NCAs, or to the Adhering Organizations. For reference, the forms include the full name, date and place of birth, and nationality of the candidate; postal and electronic addresses; the University, year, and subject of the Ph.D. or equivalent degree; the current affiliation and occupation, and the IAU Division(s) which the candidate wishes to join, 1 letter/document from the department granting the PhD, a list of past publications plus any additional information required by the NCA or Adhering Organization.

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IAU Individual Members and Junior Members do not pay dues to the Union.

The Expert Committee has evaluated your research proposal and I am glad to inform you that this proposal has been provisionally accepted by the Council for the award of Post-Doctoral Fellowship for a period of two years, subject to the fulfilment of the terms and conditions of the fellowships and will be governed by the Guidelines of the ICSSR Fellowships.

You are expected to work under the guidance of a working senior social scientist, preferably from the discipline of your research, who will certify the progress of your work at every stage. As per the ICSSR rule, PDF supervisor should be at least at the level of an Associate Professor and should be in regular employment at the affiliating institution.

Since you are presently employed, your fellowship amount would be equivalent to your present pay as per the fellowship norms. Besides, a contingency grant of Rs.20,000/- per annum will be given to cover the expenses on travel, data collection, computer work, stationery, books etc. You will have to work full time on this project and will not accept any other assignment (with or without payment) without the prior approval of the ICSSR.

Post-Doctoral Fellows are required to affiliate themselves to a public funded university or academic / research institution or ICSSR funded / recognized institution of their choice with the approval of the Council. Funds are disbursed by the ICSSR through the affiliating institution.



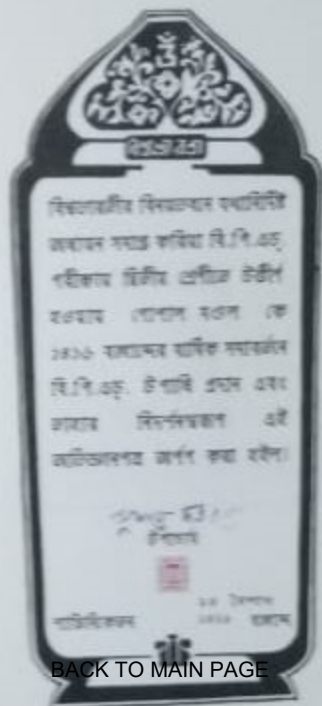

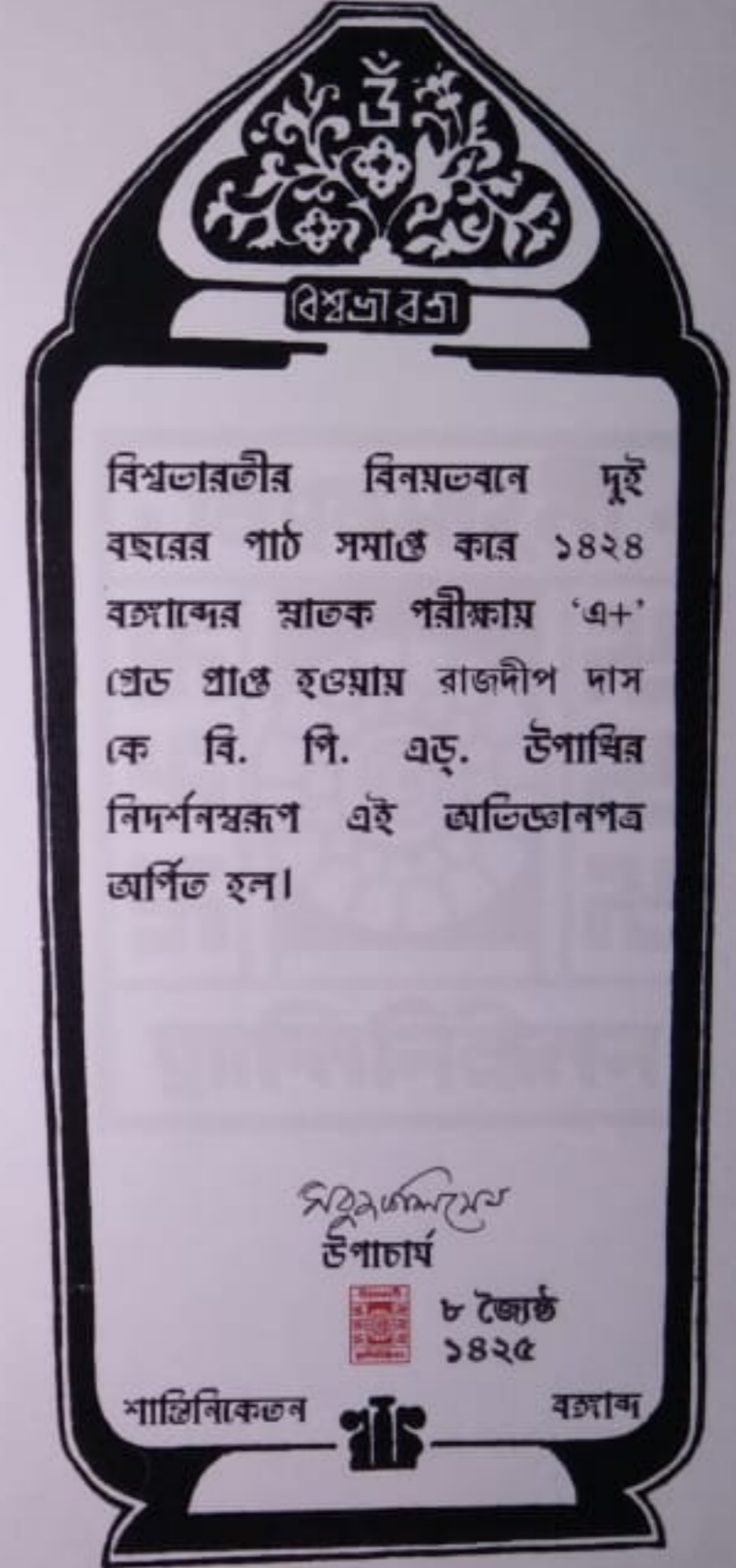

In this regard, Secretary, UGC has already requested the universities to help students in Aadhaar enrolment vide D.O. No. F.14-34/2011 (CPP-13) dated 11.01.2013.

It may please be noted that the award is liable to be cancelled by Implementing/Awarding agency and it will also attract legal action against the Awardee in the following cases:

- i. If the awardee is found to be ineligible to receive the award at any point during the entire duration of fellowship.
- ii. Misconduct of Awardee.
- iii. Unsatisfactory progress of research work.
- iv. Failure in any examination related to M.Phil./Ph.D.
- v. In case any other fellowship is drawn from other source(s).
- vi. Concealment of facts.
