

Kala Bhavana Nandan Museum is an academic museum, basically it helps to the art students for their academic programme and provide great assistance to the art historians & scholars.

The Museum of this art institution began during the year in 1919—when Kala Bhavana (the Faculty of Fine arts) was founded by Rabindranath Tagore. ‘Nava-Nandan’ the new building of Kala Bhavan Museum was setup in the year 1965, and it was inaugurated by the then Chancellor (*Acharya*) Smt. Indira Gandhi and Principal (*Adhakshya*) of Kala-Bhavana Sri Nandalal Bose.

At present, Kala-Bhavana Museum has two occasionally display gallery at ground floor and first floor of the building. Along with this some selected art works from museum collections are also in display on wall of the museum to emphasize the educational role of museum. Basically the gallery adds effort to display art works from museum collections, arrange exhibitions to promote art and artists, arrange different workshop, seminar and documentary film show for the students, teachers, and scholars.
