FRENCH DIPLOMA COURSE – One year course

Paper I: Grammar and Ideas and knowledge related to French civilization.(B1 level as per Common European Reference for Languages)

Objective: Developing language skills by learning grammatical structures and introducing the learner to contemporary French civilization.

Learning outcome: the learner develops communicative skills and becomes conversant with the French society and civilization of the present day.

Paper II :Reading of excerpts from literary texts and history of French literature

Objective: Getting the student familiar with literary style and with French literary history from the Middle Ages to the present day.

Learning outcome : The student is expected to acquire specialized knowledge of literary and cultural traditions of France and to get introduced to subtle nuances of French language.

Paper III : Composition

Objective: Developing writing skills of the learner

Learning Outcome: Developing the student's ability to compose letters and small paragraphs in French.

Paper IV: Oral

Objective: Developing oral language skills in different situations of communication.

Learning outcome: Ability to express oneself freely and fluently in French.
