Foreign Casual Course in Bengali for One Year

Syllabus for the Foreign-Casual Course in Bengali for the Foreigners has been prepared in consideration with more linguistic insight. The structure of Bengali will be introduced in graded fashion from simple to complex. Students are supposed to be acquainted with 1. Speaking 2. Reading 3. Writing and 4. Understanding ability to achieve the learning proficiency of Bengali. Teacher will prepare his lessons in addition to the textbook recommended in the syllabus. Phonetic drills should be given to the students for correct pronunciation and better understanding of phonetic contrastand its distribution. For teaching Bengali script letters should be introduced on the basis of their similarity in shape. Secondary vowel symbols will be given along with primary symbols. A few consonant conjuncts will be introduced. Teacher will explain the inconsistency between spelling and pronunciation.
